Having a Crash Recorder on board means your car is equipped with additional legal certainty. After all, you want to be able to prove your innocence and not just protest it.

With a free Crash Recorder, you will always be on the safe side. It records all the important data needed to reconstruct the events leading up to an accident.

Three steps to getting a Crash Recorder

1. We recommend that you take out motor vehicle insurance from AXA. Do you already have motor vehicle insurance from AXA? Then simply call 0800 809 809 or contact your advisor.
2. Call up Carglass, AXA's installation partner, to set up an appointment. Have the Crash Recorder installed within 30 days of when the insurance starts.
3. Take your car to a Carglass Service Center on the agreed date. If going to a Service Center is too inconvenient, you can also have the Crash Recorder installed at a location of your choice. Please be sure to have your vehicle registration to hand.

How does the Crash Recorder work?

The Crash Recorder saves data from 20 seconds before until 10 seconds after an accident. It records the following:

- Acceleration in the direction of travel and in a sideways direction
- Changes in the speed resulting from a collision
- Date and time of the accident

This makes it possible to draw conclusions about the causes of the accident. The Crash Recorder is useful when reconstructing the events of an accident quickly and objectively and provides legal certainty.

Goals and motives

Thanks to the Crash Recorder, it is now possible to reconstruct the events leading up to an accident more precisely and more quickly. AXA wants to make the most of this advantage while also helping to reduce the risk of an accident. We are convinced that the Crash Recorder has a preventive effect because drivers in cars equipped with a Crash Recorder take fewer risks and drive more carefully.

Technical aspects

The Crash Recorder

- Is small and can be installed under a car seat.
- Is not a surveillance instrument. It saves data only in connection with an accident. In the event of a collision, the data it saves can be used to reconstruct the accident objectively.
- Is not connected to the car's electronic systems. It runs on a separate battery, which must be replaced after approximately four years. AXA will contact you in due time.

Installation and removal

AXA will pay for both the device and its installation. If you cancel the insurance, you will have to remove the Crash Recorder and return it to AXA.
